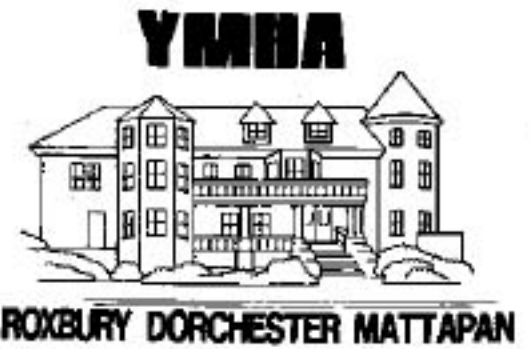

With her long illness, we knew that time was not on her side, yet we were still unprepared for a world without Faye.

Superlatives are always articulated for those who have died, and deservedly so. Her superlatives of being a loving wife to Ed, a wonderful mother to Marc and Jodi, a precious daughter and sister remain.

Other superlatives are in order for Faye as well, for she was a special person, one who was so giving and desirous of making others happy. Her work with and for the Y.M.H.A. Alumni Association was performed with quintessential dedication.
